Thus, for the 3rd Quarter two (2) bills were passed into law, i.e., the Unified National Identification (ID) System Act and Occupational Safety and Health Hazards Compliance Act. Furthermore, the LEDAC Technical Working Group met on August 9, 2018 and one Preliminary LEDAC meeting was conducted on August 13, 2018 and attended to by concerned cabinet secretaries.
